

The Second and Third Conditional Exercises

1. **SITUATION:** Your friend was hungry because they skipped breakfast.

You say:

(eat) breakfast, (not/be) hungry.

2. **SITUATION: SITUATION:** You don't have enough money to travel abroad.

You say:

(have) more money, (travel) abroad.

3. **SITUATION:** Your friend ate too much fast food and felt sick.

You say:

(eat) healthy food, (feel) better.

4. **SITUATION:** You didn't put the milk in the fridge, and it was spoiled.

You say:

(put) the milk in the fridge, (not/go) bad.

5. **SITUATION:** Your friend made soup but forgot to add salt.

You say:

(add) salt, (taste) better.

6. **SITUATION:** You wanted to bake cookies, but you didn't buy flour.

You say:

(buy) flour, (make) cookies.

7. **SITUATION:** Your friend didn't wash the vegetables before eating them.

You say:

(wash) the vegetables, (be) safer to eat.

8. **SITUATION:** You left your sandwich at home and had nothing to eat for lunch.

You say:

(bring) my sandwich, (have) lunch.

9. **SITUATION:** Your friend drank coffee late at night and couldn't sleep.

You say:

(not/drink) coffee late, (sleep) better.

10. **SITUATION:** You made a cake but forgot to preheat the oven.

You say:

(preheat) the oven, (bake) the cake properly.

11. **SITUATION:** You live in a small apartment and don't have a garden.

You say:

(live) in a big house, (have) a garden.

12. **SITUATION:** She isn't good at singing, so she isn't in a band.

You say:

(be) good at singing, (be) in a band.

13. **SITUATION** Your friend doesn't speak Spanish and can't work in Spain.

You say:

(speak) Spanish, (work) in Spain.

14. **SITUATION** She doesn't have a bicycle, so she walks to work.

You say:

(have) a bicycle, (not/walk) to work.

15. **SITUATION** You didn't know how to cook, so you always ate out.

You say:

(know) how to cook, (not/eat) out so often.

16. **SITUATION** They don't live near the beach, so they can't go swimming every day.

You say:

(live) near the beach, (go) swimming every day.

17. **SITUATION** You don't have a lot of free time, so you can't learn a new skill.

You say:

(have) more free time, (learn) a new skill.
